  - Course Syllabus
  - Learning Outcomes and Course Outcomes
  - Course Schedule (15-16 weeks)
  - A lesson Plan: An overview of how the course is built up, including an overview of resources and learning activities as well as assessment tools used

6. What's your reflection on the OBE-SCL workshop(s) you have attended? Please write at least two paragraphs and be specific about what you learned and what could be improved for future.
7. What's your reflection on your teaching skills? Have you implemented or started to implement what you learned in the OBE-SCL training workshops? What are some of your strengths and weaknesses in regards to teaching?
